Dear sister how are you by now due hope you are well we are all very well we have had some of the hottest and driest weather here my garden is burned up it drowned out in the spring our potatoes are not very good this year I have canned everything I could I put up eight jars of carrots this morning we have been going to church they have a big meeting going nearly all the time we had a letter from Clarence they were all well hadn't seen Inez at all yet Burt's mother said if you ever come back she wanted you to stay and visit with her we have had several letters from Clara Visses Burke that is Visses girl she is coming

To see us this fall she is Mary has one child we have ??? over one hundred chicks sold 13 this morning have one hen sitting yet Times is harder here now than I ever seen.

What are all the folks doing out there I work all the time and don't do anything. I haven't been stout this year like common can't hardly see to sew at all Edwards baby is a great big boy can't say anything he wants to we'll close for this time don't you wait like I did well I'll do better next time right soon and tell all the News what is the boys doing don't think you can read this right soon your old sister
