Mangum, Okla Apr 29, 1934

Dear Mother, I will try to get a letter written to you this evening so Lewis can mail it in the morning. I intended to write last week but just didn't get it done. I wrote to Atta and was so sleepy when I got through I just quit and went to bed. I sent your letter to Atta and told Amy what was in it. We went over there last Sun. evening.

They were all well and getting along alright. We took them a lot of garden seed. Amy wrote and wanted to know if we had any garden seed, said they didn't have any and no way to get any. We have had some good rains lately, our gardens are looking fine. We will make a few peaches and currants. Lewis got Mr. Sullivan to plant the new ground east of the road. Planted it in cane, feed, beans and butter-beans. Left a few

rows to plant in peanuts. They have most of the land planted now. We have bushel of winter onions over at the little garden. Arthur and Vera came home yesterday got here about the time we got our breakfast dishes up. Arthur brought a lot of dirty clothes and Vera brought a few so they had to wash and iron. They started back about 2 o'clock this evening. Lorraine and her niece came Friday evening. Lorraine staid all night and

her niece begged to stay but her daddy promised to bring her back Sat. and let her stay all day — while he took the Reed boys and girls to the track meet. Lorraine staid again Sat. night and we took her to Reed this evening. Her sister and brother aim to teach school another year at Reed. That will be five years for them at Reed. Then they plan to go to Arkansas and buy a little place. Arthur hasn't got a job for next year yet. They asked him

to teach again at Lake Valley but he thought he could do better so they told him they would hold the place until a certain time in case he changed his mind. He didn't accept it so they have a teacher for that place now. He went to Clinton Mon. evening to apply for a position but they had just signed up for the position he wanted that evening — offered him a position in Jr. High, but that wasn't what he wanted said he had waited so

He never did go to see about the job at Altus they wanted him for so I guess they decided he didn't want it and got somebody else. We are still having good weather here. She is feeling pretty well.
